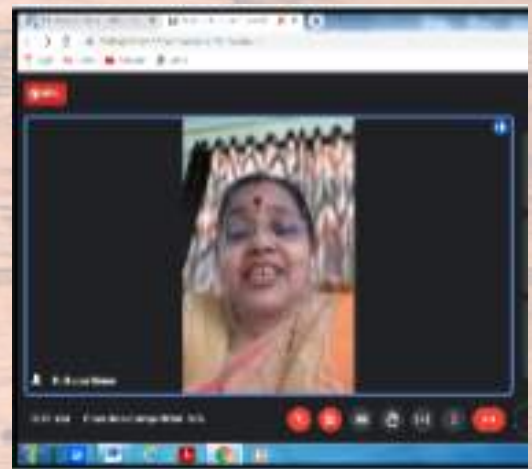

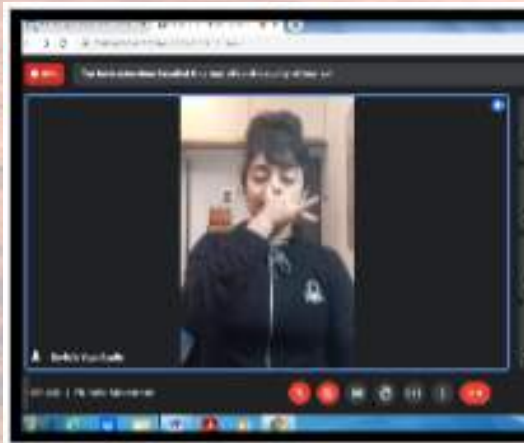

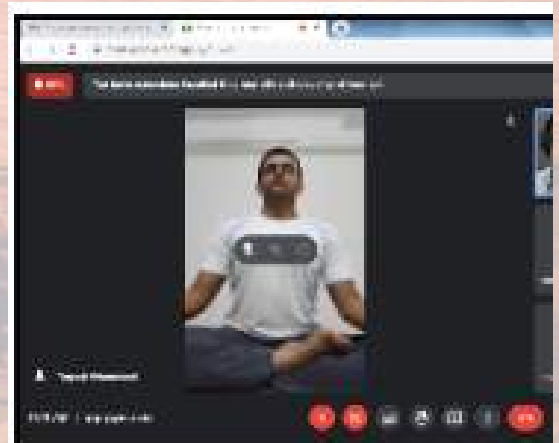

# National Cadet Corps - N. C. C.

The N.C.C. focuses on fostering the comprehensive development of young individuals, emphasizing crucial values like Discipline, Patriotism, Secularism, Selflessness, Courage, Hard work, Sportsmanship, and Adventure. It also aims to establish a team of youths who can be inducted into the Indian Armed Forces, such as the Army, Navy, Air Force, and other Paramilitary forces. N.C.C. enrollment is voluntary. R. K. Talreja College's N.C.C. unit, led by Lt. Badgujar Bharat, is affiliated with 6 MAH BN NCC MUMBAI 'A' Group and has surpassed the expected aims and objectives. The objectives of N.C.C. are to provide a conducive environment to encourage young people to pursue a career in the Armed Forces and to nurture Character, Camaraderie, Discipline, Leadership, Secularism, the Spirit of adventure, and the ideals of Selfless Service among the youth of the Nation.

The N.C.C. offers a Special Entry Scheme for SD Wings Graduates in OTA aged between 19-25 years with 50% marks, through DDG of States for a direct Interview (SSB) every year. Cadets who have obtained 'A' or 'B' grades in the 'C' Certificate Examination are exempted from the CDS examination conducted by UPSC. In the Academic year 2021-2022, the following activities were conducted by the Unit:

## 1. INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY:-

International Yoga Day is celebrated on **21st June** every year to promote physical, mental, and spiritual well-being through the practice of Yoga. It was declared by the United Nations General Assembly in 2014, to raise awareness about the numerous benefits of Yoga, including stress reduction, improved flexibility, and increased mindfulness. Yoga enthusiasts all over the world participate in various events and activities to celebrate the day. Yoga Day was conducted from home because of the lockdown. On Yoga Day, COY COMMANDER L.T BHARAT. U. BADGUJAR and 52 cadets took part in this 'traditional workout' to stay fit.





## 2. TREE PLANTATION:-

Trees play a vital role in the Environment by providing oxygen, absorbing carbon dioxide, preventing soil erosion, providing shelter and food for birds and animals, and helping to maintain the Ecological balance. 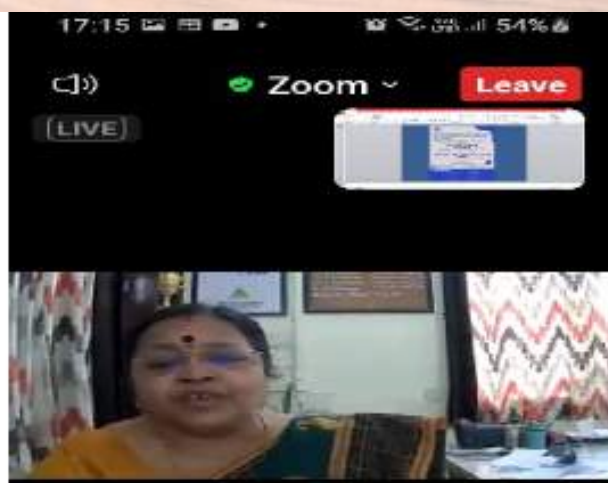

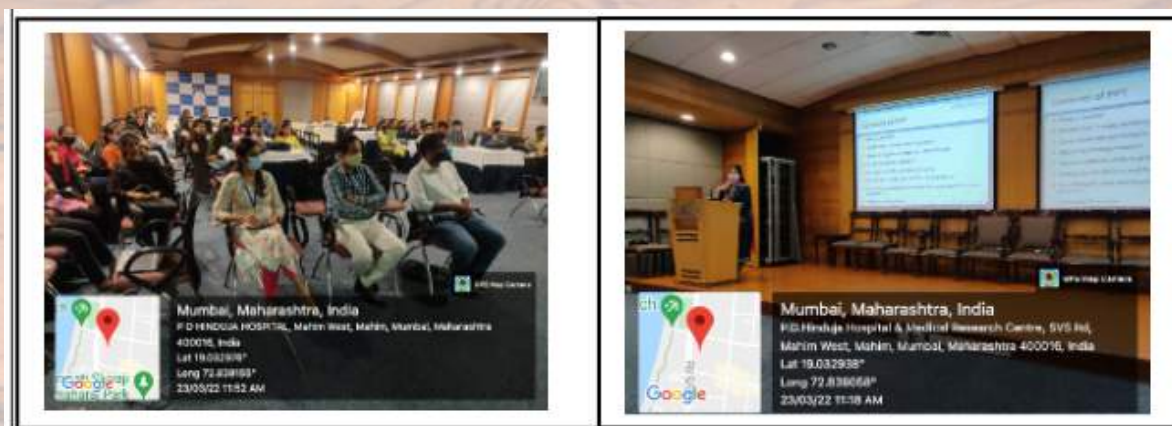

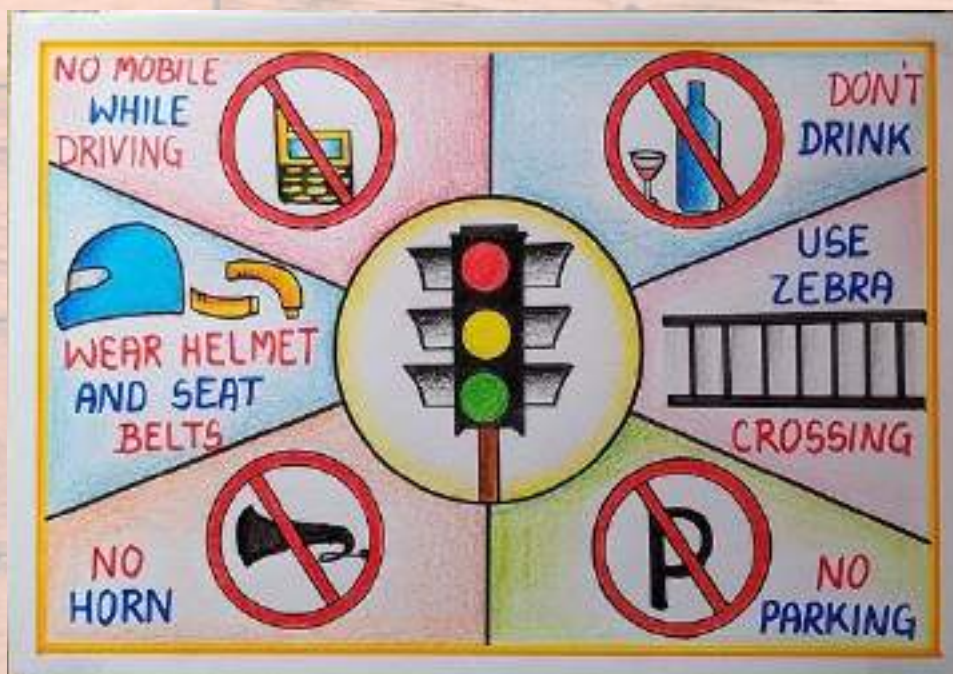

3. Guidance on PET and selection of Research topic

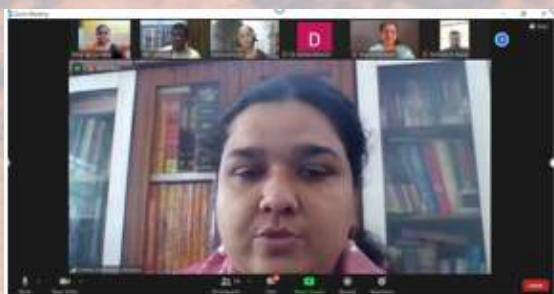
The program was well received by the participants. They understood the significance of Research in further studies.

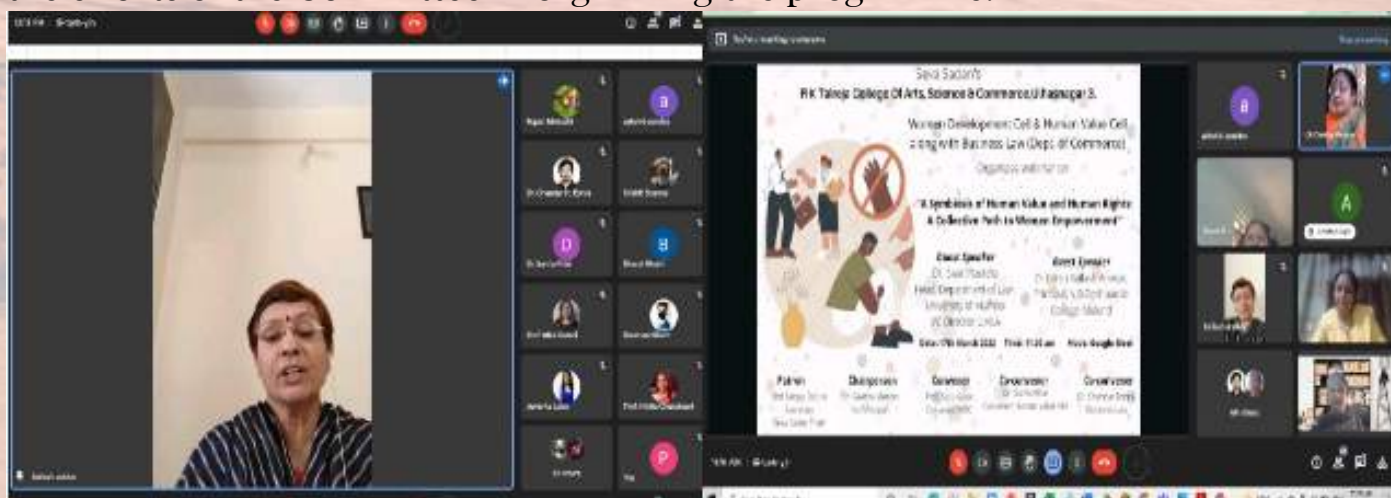
# Women Development Cell

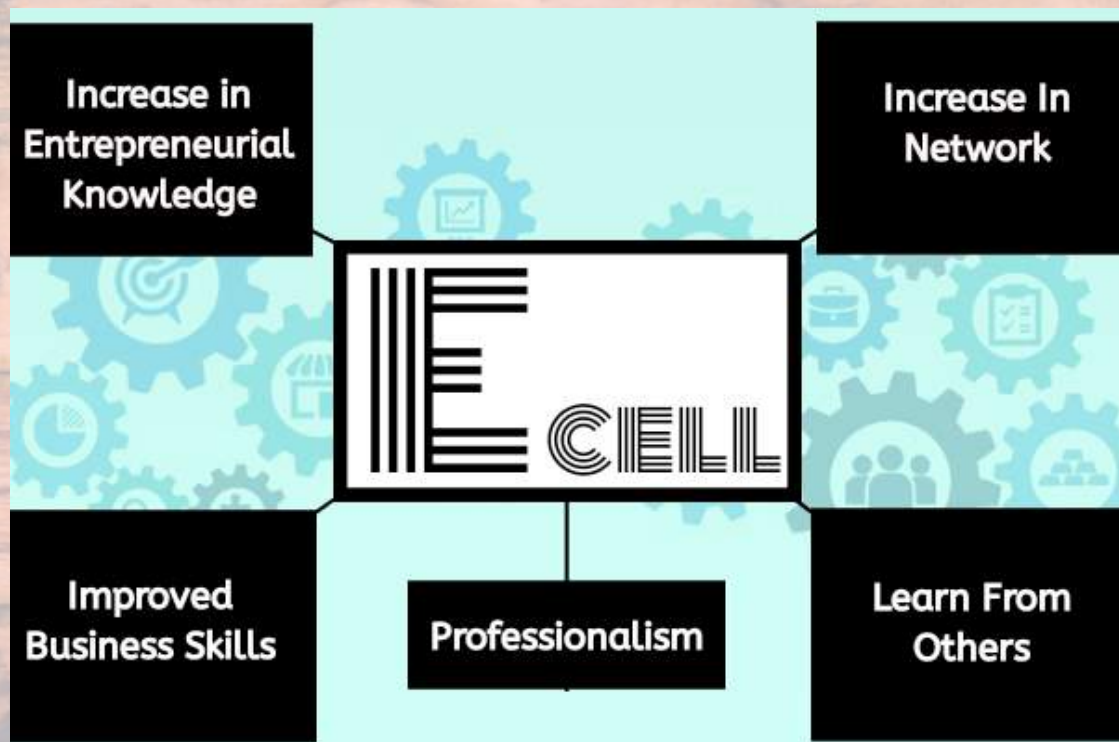


# Entrepreneurship Cell

# Undergraduate Research Cell

The Cell hosted a **National Level Webinar on How to Fuel Your Research With Your Inquisitiveness** on **1st October, 2021**. **Dr. Sasikumar N. Menon, Director, IATRIS, Sion and Asst. Prof, Pharma Analytical Sciences, Ruia College, Mumbai** was invited as the Guest Speaker. 89 participants attended the event with the objective of:

- To create awareness and nurture Research Culture among the undergraduate student.
- Provide a platform to know the opportunities in Research and Development.
- To Fuel Research With Your Inquisitiveness by encouraging research in newly emerging and challenging areas and multidisciplinary fields.

Students were informed about the importance of Research and introduced to Action Research and its process and importance. Students interacted with the Resource person and gained knowledge about different topics of Research in Science and ways to inculcate research with inquisitiveness.

Online short course was conducted on **Technical Communication for Scientific Community and Introduction to Research Methodology** during the months of October and November 2021. **Mr. Bhriugu Rishi Mishra from the Dept. of Energy Science, IIT Bombay** was invited as the Guest Speaker. 50 students attended the Webinar. The objectives of the Webinar were:

- To bring awareness about Scientific communication among young Researchers.
- To enhance the ability of young minds to conduct meaningful research.
- To encourage budding talent to take up Research Inventions and Innovative projects

The short course was planned to prepare our Science students to take up Inventions and provide training for effective Scientific Communication. The course covered all the basic fundamental aspects of Research Methodology with Scientific Communication strategies. The course also covered advanced tools like Monte Carlo simulation and its application in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology, Engineering, and the Basics of Python/Matlab.

Course Content: Annexure I

1. From **1st October 2021 to 30th November 2021** every Saturday from 5:00 to 7:00 pm, Online lectures were scheduled.
2. Every week students were provided with two hours of actual teaching,
3. Reference material and 2 hours of preparatory work. The course concluded with group project preparation and presentation and assessment test based on the overall course content. The course completion certificates were issued to only those students who appeared in the final assessment test. Out of 50 students, 29 students successfully completed the course.



The Cell hosted the 16th Inter-Collegiate/Institute/Department **Avishkar Research Convention** AY-2021-22. Members of the Cell facilitated the event where 29 students presented their research with the objective to promote research activity and mentor our students to represent the College at the University level. Out of a total of 15 project proposals submitted, 7 were selected for the final round which was the highest from Zone 3. Hence our College grabbed **FIRST** position and was awarded the **Champion's Certificate** in the Selection round from Navi Mumbai Zone. The Winning Project had the following details:

**Project Title:** Train Station: Potential hub of MDR Bacteria

**Students enrolled:** 1. Nishad Sapugade (SYBSc); 2. Nupur Gholap (SYBSc)

**Aim of the project:** To isolate and characterize bacteria from various touch sites in a suburban railway station environment.

**Research Design:**

- To isolate bacteria from the suburban railway station environment
- To characterize them using morphological and biochemical techniques
- To check the susceptibility of those isolates to different antibiotics
- To check the virulence factors of isolates

**Findings:**

Personal and Environmental hygiene is crucial in the spread of infectious disease agent. Pathogens in public areas like Public transport systems will be a critical Public Health issue due to the ease of transfer of such pathogens. The situation is more problematic when such pathogens are resistant to multiple antibiotics. There are several reports worldwide stating the presence of multidrug-resistant pathogens in Public transport systems but there is a paucity of data from India. 52 swab samples from various touch sites of the Kalyan Railway station environment have been procured and processed. 7 isolates of *Staphylococcus aureus* and 6 isolates of *Escherichia Coli* have been isolated and were found to be resistant to multiple antibiotics. Presently checking of virulence factors of these isolates and their susceptibility to various disinfectants is under study.

**Outcome:**

The Study highlights the hygienic conditions associated with touch sites in a suburban railway station environment.

## **UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH CELL**

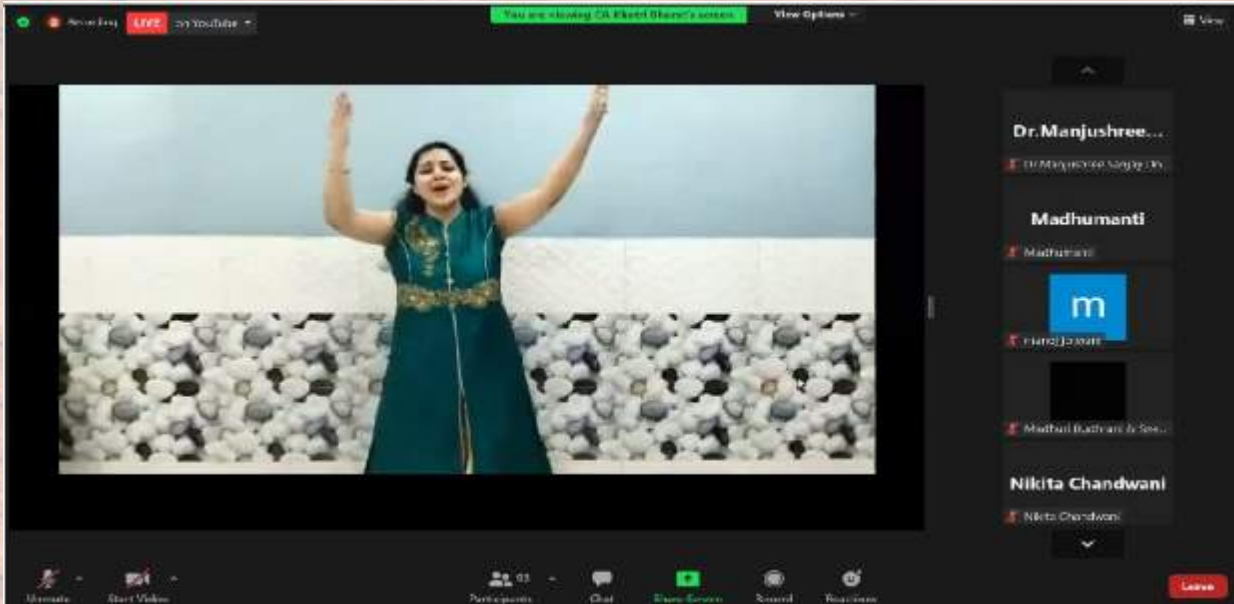


# Sindhi Sahitya Mandal

# मराठी भाषा संवर्धन पंधरवडा

मराठी भाषेचे जतन, संवर्धन व्हावे या हेतूने १४ जानेवारी ते २८ जानेवारी हा कालावधी 'मराठी भाषा संवर्धन पंधरवडा' म्हणून साजरा करण्यात यावा, असा शासन निर्णय आहे (शासन निर्णय क्र. मभापं -२०१९ / प्र.क्र.१११ /भाषा -२, दि. १८.०९.२०२०). हा निर्णय प्रमाण मानून कार्यक्रमांची आखणी करण्यात आली. वास्तविक पाहता, सेवा सदनच्या आर. के. तलरेजा महाविद्यालयात हा कार्यक्रम दरवर्षी अत्यंत जल्लोषात साजरा केला जातो. या वर्षी कोरोना महामारीचा प्रादुर्भाव असल्यामुळे ऑनलाईन पद्धतीने 'मराठी भाषा संवर्धन पंधरवडा' साजरा करण्याचे निश्चित करण्यात आले. 'विविध अभ्यासशाखांमधील मराठी भाषिकांचे योगदान' हे सूत्र केंद्रस्थानी ठेवून कार्यक्रमाची आखणी करावी, असा प्रस्ताव महाविद्यालयाच्या प्रभारी प्राचार्य डॉ. गीता मेनन यांनी मांडला. या प्रस्तावाला अनुसरून महाविद्यालयातील कला आणि विज्ञान शाखेतील विविध विभागांनी सक्रिय सहभाग घेत 'मराठी भाषा संवर्धन पंधरवडा' अभिनव पद्धतीने साजरा केला.

**१४ जानेवारी २०२२** - मराठी भाषा संवर्धन पंधरवड्याचे उद्घाटन अर्थशास्त्र विभागाच्या कार्यक्रमाने झाले. महाराष्ट्रातील विचारवंतांचे अर्थशास्त्रातील योगदान हे या कार्यक्रमाचे विचारसूत्र होते. अर्थशास्त्र विभागातील विद्यार्थ्यांनी डॉ. बाबासाहेब आंबेडकर, गोपाळ गणेश आगरकर, ज्योतिबा फुले ते भालचंद्र मुणगेकर आदी मराठी भाषिक विचारवंतांचे अर्थशास्त्रविषयक विचार पीपीटीच्या माध्यमातून अत्यंत प्रभावीपणे सादर केले.

**१५ जानेवारी २०२२** - विविध भाषांमधील ज्ञानाचे, साहित्याचे आदानप्रदान होत असताना भाषांतर, अनुवाद आणि रूपांतर या प्रक्रिया सांस्कृतिकदृष्ट्या अतिशय महत्त्वाची भूमिका बजावत असतात. या पार्श्वभूमीवर इंग्रजी विभागाने भाषांतरातील नवे /आधुनिक प्रवाह या विषयावर घेतलेला कार्यक्रम विद्यार्थ्यांच्या दृष्टीने अत्यंत उपयुक्त ठरला. निशा सेवानी या इंग्रजी विभागाच्या विद्यार्थिनीने भाषांतर, अनुवाद, रूपांतर आणि अर्वाचिनीकरण या संकल्पना स्पष्ट करत भाषांतरातील समकालीन आव्हानांची मांडणी केली. निशा सेवानी ही सिंधी भाषिक असून तिने मराठी भाषेत केलेले सादरीकरण ही सदर कार्यक्रमाची उपलब्धी आहे, असे निश्चितपणे म्हणता येईल.

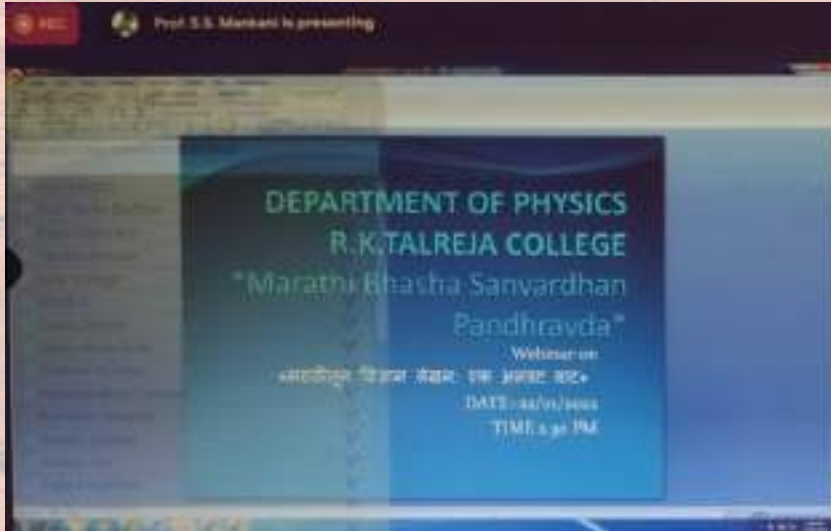
**२२ जानेवारी २०२२** - कोणतीही भाषा व्यवहार आणि ज्ञान या दोन्ही पातळ्यांवर सक्षमपणे वापरली जाणे हे तिच्या निकोप वृद्धीच्या दृष्टीने अत्यंत आवश्यक असते. आधुनिक विज्ञानातील नव्या संकल्पना मराठी भाषेत आणणे हा मराठी भाषेच्या संवर्धनाचा एक महत्त्वाचा मार्ग आहे. 'मराठीतून विज्ञान लेखन : एक अनवट वाट' या अतिशय महत्त्वाच्या विषयावरील डॉ. माधवी ठाकूरदेसाई (विभागप्रमुख, भौतिकशास्त्र विभाग, बिल्हा महाविद्यालय, कल्याण) यांचे व्याख्यान यादृष्टीने महत्त्वाचे ठरले. डॉ. माधवी ठाकूरदेसाई यांनी वैज्ञानिक संकल्पना मराठीसारख्या प्रादेशिक भाषेत आणण्यातील आव्हाने आणि त्यावर त्यांनी शोधलेले पर्याय यांची सोदाहरण मांडणी केली. ज्ञानव्यवहारातील प्रादेशिक भाषेचे अनन्यसाधारण महत्त्व अधोरेखित करणारे आणि त्यासंदर्भातील भाषिकांची जबाबदारी लक्षात आणून देणारे हे व्याख्यान अत्यंत मूल्ययुक्त ठरले. 'आधी केले मग सांगितले..' असा हा प्रवास असल्यामुळे तो निश्चितच पथदर्शक म्हणता येईल. यावर्षी अखिल भारतीय मराठी साहित्य संमेलनाचे अध्यक्ष ज्येष्ठ खगोलशास्त्रज्ञ आणि मराठी विज्ञान लेखक जयंत नारळीकर असणे आणि वरील स्वरूपाचे व्याख्यान भौतिकशास्त्र विभागाने आयोजित करणे हा सुंदर योगायोग ठरला.



२४ जानेवारी २०२२ - मानसशास्त्र विभागाच्या वतीने मानसशास्त्रातील मराठी भाषिकांचे योगदान या विषयावर डॉ. विवेक बेल्हेकर ( विभागप्रमुख, उपयोजित मानसशास्त्र विभाग, मुंबई विद्यापीठ) यांचे अत्यंत अभ्यासपूर्ण व्याख्यान पार पडले. सदर व्याख्यानात जागतिक संदर्भात विद्यापीठीय पातळीवरील मानसशास्त्र विभागाच्या ऐतिहासिक जडणघडणीचा तपशीलवार मागोवा घेण्यात आला. महाराष्ट्रातील मुंबई, पुणे आणि नागपूर विद्यापीठात कार्यरत असणाऱ्या मराठी भाषिक प्राध्यापकांचे मानसशास्त्राच्या विविध शाखांमधील योगदान तसेच मराठी भाषेत मानसशास्त्रीय चाचण्या उपलब्ध करून देण्यातील मूल्ययुक्त योगदान डॉ. विवेक बेल्हेकरांनी अत्यंत प्रभावी पद्धतीने अधोरेखित केले. मुंबई विद्यापीठाच्या मानसशास्त्र विभागातील विद्यार्थी, प्रगती महाविद्यालयाचे विद्यार्थी आणि प्राध्यापक सदर कार्यक्रमात सहभागी झाले होते. स्वाभाविकच, हा कार्यक्रम आंतरमहाविद्यालयीन स्वरूपाचा ठरला.

२५ जानेवारी २०२२ - हिंदी विभागाने हिंदी भाषेत अनुवादित झालेल्या मराठी साहित्याचे सादरीकरण करणारा अतिशय चांगला कार्यक्रम सादर केला. अखिल भारतीय मराठी साहित्य परिषद, उत्तर महाराष्ट्र शाखेचे अध्यक्ष डॉ.आनंद अहिरे या कार्यक्रमास प्रमुख अतिथी म्हणून उपस्थित होते. त्यांनी मराठी भाषेची उत्पत्ती आणि एकूण ऐतिहासिक जडणघडण या संदर्भात विद्यार्थ्यांना मार्गदर्शन केले.

मध्ययुगीन काळातील मराठी साहित्यातील मानदंड मानल्या जाणाऱ्या ज्ञानेश्वर, नामदेव, तुकाराम, बहिणाबाई आणि जनाबाई या अनुक्रमे संतकवी आणि संतकवयित्रींच्या अभंगांचे विद्यार्थ्यांनी प्रभावी अभिवाचन केले. सदर कार्यक्रमात अखिल भारतीय साहित्य संमेलनाचे अध्यक्ष, ज्येष्ठ खगोलशास्त्रज्ञ आणि मराठी विज्ञान लेखक जयंत नारळीकरांच्या साहित्याचा परिचय करून देण्यात आला. सी. एच. एम. आणि साकेत महाविद्यालयातील प्राध्यापक आणि विद्यार्थी या कार्यक्रमात सक्रिय सहभागी होते. त्यामुळे सलग दुसरा कार्यक्रम आंतरमहाविद्यालयीन पातळीवर घडवून आणण्याचा प्रयत्न यशस्वी झाला, असे म्हणता येईल.





**२७ जानेवारी २०२२** - सूक्ष्मजीवशास्त्र विभागाने 'सूक्ष्मजीवशास्त्र आणि मानवी जीवन' या विषयावर व्याख्यान आयोजित केले होते. डॉ. अरविंद देशमुख (अध्यक्ष, मायक्रोबायोलॉजिस्ट सोसायटी ऑफ इंडिया) यांनी सूक्ष्म जीव आणि मानवी अस्तित्व यांच्या अनेकस्तरीय सहसंबंधाविषयी अत्यंत सोप्या भाषेत माहिती दिली. # Department of Psychology

# Department of Economics

## **Activity 1: Orientation**

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the College continued to conduct Online lectures. Due to the Pandemic, the University changed the Examination pattern. This situation was new for the Teachers as well as the students. To make our students aware of Online teaching, the Department conducted an Orientation program for Arts and Commerce (Economics) streams.

## **Activity 2:**

### **Two Days' Workshop on Revised Syllabus MA I and MA II (Economics)**

The Department of Economics has a long history of Aided PG Departments earlier with SPPU, Pune, and presently with the University of Mumbai. Our Departmental colleagues have extended their cooperation to the earlier Ad Hoc BOS in Economics, and present BOS in Economics in terms of conduct of the Capacity building program, University Examination-related support, and support to the Syllabus Revision Committee as and when required basis. To continue with such a legacy, the Department of Economics jointly organized a **Two Day Syllabus Revision Workshop for MA (Economics) Semester I, II, III & IV in collaboration with the Board of Studies (BOS), Economics, University of Mumbai on September 22 - 23, 2021.**

Due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 Pandemic as well as the subsequent lockdown declared under the Disaster Management Act 2005, every aspect such as conceptualization, planning, publicity, organizing process, presentation through video conferencing mode, monitoring and certificate distribution, etc. have been managed through Online mode with the active participation and networking among the organizing Committee members. The Objectives of this workshop are:

- (1) To discuss the syllabus prepared by BoS Economics University of Mumbai, and
- (2) To clear the queries of participants regarding the syllabus.

Out of 80 Faculty consisting of 32 female and 48 male faculty members across different colleges affiliated with the University of Mumbai.

The Outcomes achieved through this workshop are:

- (1) participants had a very healthy discussion on every paper included in the syllabus, (2) Question-answer session cleared all the doubts regarding the syllabus, paper pattern, assignments, and 100-mark project.

The feedback from participants was excellent. Overall, the experience of the participants was good. Participants expressed their views that they need a separate workshop on Quantitative Methods and Research Methodology papers.

## **Activity 3: महाराष्ट्रातील आर्थिक विचारवंतांचे अर्थशास्त्रातील योगदान**

As a part of a new initiative under the celebration of the “मराठी भाषा संवर्धन पंधरवडा” program, the Department of Economics conducted a PowerPoint Presentation Webinar by the students to promote understanding of contribution in Maharashtra's



Economics Development through the Marathi language on **January 14, 2022**, for 3 hours duration through online video conferencing mode. The objectives are as follows:

- (1) To develop Presentation techniques for students, and

#### **Activity 4: ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION**

Every year the Department of Economics conducts an **Essay Writing Competition** to promote writing skills on Contemporary issues among students across all disciplines. To continue with such a legacy for this Academic year 2021-22, the Department of Economics in coordination with the Planning Forum conducted an "Essay Writing Competition " for our students on February 4, 2022, with help of active participation of all the members of the Department. The objectives of this program are:

- (1) to develop writing skills,
- (2) to give an opportunity to demonstrate creative writing, and
- (3) to create awareness among students about current economic and social issues.

Out of 116 students registered for this competition, 44 students consisting of 33 female and 11 male students submitted their essays in pdf format. Due to COVID-19, this time the essay competition was conducted in Online mode. All essay topics were based on the current Socio-Economic issues in India as follows:

Students were allowed to write essays in Hindi, Marathi, or English language. The three best essays were selected by Judges - Ms. Ashwini Pendse and Mr. Pramod Dagade.

Prizes were announced in the Prize distribution ceremony which was held on **11th April 2022**. Prize Winners and all participants were awarded with a Certificate and trophy.

The outcome achieved through this program is:

- (1) Participants used this opportunity to showcase their writing skills.
- (2) Participants got an overview of how to research topics and
- (3) Participants gathered the information from authentic sources and learned about the economic and social issues of India.

#### **Activity 5: Women's Day Celebration on 9th March 2022**

On the occasion of International Women's Day, on Wednesday, **9th March 2022**, the Planning Forum and Department of Economics organized an Inauguration ceremony for Sanitary Napkin Vending Machines on the College Campus. Dr. Manjushree Dole, HoD Economics and Convener, Planning Forum put tremendous efforts into getting 5 Sanitary Napkin Vending Machines, 2 Incinerator Machine and 1 Hot and Cold-water dispenser from one anonymous donor and Women and Child Development Committee, Ulhasnagar Municipal Corporation.

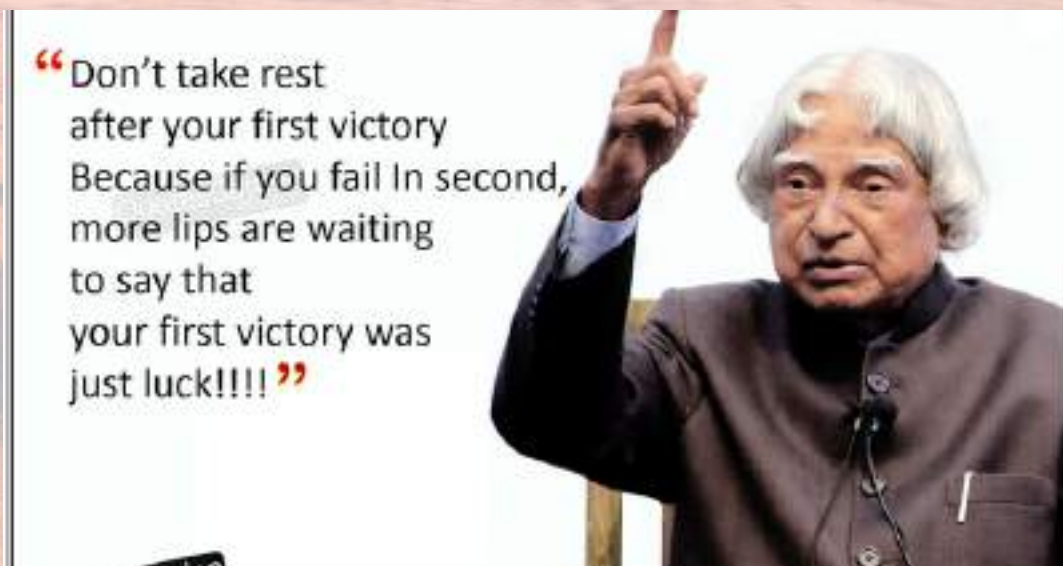
