

Coordinated by Dr. Santosh Motwani, Dr. Reena Singh, and Mr. Sunil Khatri as Programme Officers, along with Mr. Vinit Chitte, Mr. Subhash Gaded, and Dr. Prajakta Shitre as members, the NSS unit embarked on a journey to foster the spirit of volunteerism among its 300 volunteers. International Day of Yoga: International Yoga Day is dedicated to elevating global awareness of the myriad advantages of practicing yoga, promoting its potential to foster healthier lifestyles worldwide. This observance underscores the




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World AIDS Day:



This, in turn, enables students to achieve a balance between academic rigor and physical activity. By allowing students to interact with peers from diverse backgrounds, Gymkhana activities enhance community bonding, social networking, and emotional intelligence. These events also equip students with essential leadership and organizational skills, invaluable in their future professional lives. Gymkhana represents a crucial aspect of college life, offering a holistic approach to both social and personal development, not limited to athletic prowess.

Engagement in Competitions

Under the Gymkhana umbrella, students are encouraged to partake in a plethora of competitions ranging from Intercollegiate to National levels. The Academic year 2022-23 marked the resumption of various Tournaments at District, University, State, and National levels, witnessing enthusiastic participation from our students. This revival brought back the life and spark to Gymkhana after two years of hiatus caused by COVID-19.

Degree College Achievements

Our Degree college teams, both boys and girls, showcased their talents in numerous games at the Intercollegiate level and those organized by the University of Mumbai.

Athletics: Our athletes excelled in the Intercollegiate Athletic Meet, with notable achievements in the Thane Zone III, qualifying for the Inter-Zone competitions. Divya Singh clinched the second place in Javelin throw, whereas Manmohan Singh Bhadouriya secured the third place in Javelin and participated in the All India Inter-University Athletic meet. Dattaram Dalvi triumphed in the Pune District Junior Athletic Championship 2022 for the 10 Km walk and continued his winning streak by securing the first place in the Men under 20, 10,000m Race walk at the Maharashtra State Junior Athletic Championship 2022. Dalvi also represented Maharashtra in the 10,000 m Race Walk at an event organized by the Gujarat Athletics Association in Nadiad, securing the fourth rank. **Best Physique:** Our boys' team participated in the Thane Zone III Best Physique tournament, demonstrating strength and discipline.

Cross Country: The boys' team achieved the fourth place in the Thane Zone III cross country tournament held at Kalyan, showcasing endurance and teamwork.

Football: The boys' team competed in the Thane Zone III football match, with **Vishal Sharma** advancing to the Inter-zone tournament.

Handball: Our female players, Manasi Sethi and Sakshi Pardeshi, represented us in the Inter-Zonal Handball tournament, displaying skill and agility.

Kabaddi: The boys' team secured the fourth place in the Thane Zone III, with **Vivek Gite, Deepak Gupta, and Atharva Pisal** advancing to the Inter-Zone Kabaddi tournament.

Powerlifting: Demonstrating strength and determination, the boys' team participated in the Thane Zone III Powerlifting tournament.

Shooting: The girls' team won the Thane Zone III shooting tournament and secured the third place, with the boys' team also participating.

Squash: Our boys' team claimed the third place in the Thane Zone and qualified for the Inter-Zone. **Mohit Tanwar** secured the second place in the All India Inter-University Squash tournament.

Taek-Won-Do: Tejal Gaike and Muzzamil Mirza made their mark in the Thane Zone III Taek-won-do tournament, with Mirza securing the first place and achieving the third place in the Inter-zonal competition.

Volleyball: The girls' team participated in the Thane Zone III Volleyball tournament, with **Kavita Pal** advancing to the Inter-zone level. The boys' team won the first place in the Thane Zone III, with **Gajendra Raghav** and **Laxman Thapa** moving on to the inter-zone level and securing the third place. Raghav also participated in the All India Inter-University Volley Ball tournament and the **'Ashwamedh' event in Aurangabad**.

Intercollegiate Competitions



- **Book-Bank Scheme:** Over six hundred students benefited from the Book-Bank Scheme, underscoring our commitment to support our student community.


- **Financial Support**: The library was awarded a grant of Rs.1,67,000/- by the University of Mumbai, bolstering our resources for recovery and development.



In a strategic move to further enhance the Institution's capabilities, the college completed the necessary procedures to qualify as a "Centre of Excellence." This designation is expected to significantly benefit the college by making it eligible for government funding, which will support the implementation of various schemes aimed at improving student outcomes. To ensure that all prospective and current students are aware of the Career Katta program, it has been prominently included in the college prospectus. Information about the program is also actively disseminated through WhatsApp groups, a strategy that has effectively increased its visibility and popularity among the student body.

Representatives from the college attended two One-day workshops; one at Birla College in Kalyan and another at Joshi Bedekar College in Thane. These workshops provided valuable learning experiences and networking opportunities, further enhancing the program's effectiveness. Regular engagement in over ten weekly meetings throughout the year has also played a critical role in the continuous development and refinement of the Career Katta program. Overall, the integration of the Career Katta platform at R.K. Talreja College has marked a significant advancement in educational support services, directly contributing to the enrichment of student capabilities and their preparation for successful careers.


Field Visit to the Ulhas Vastu Sangrahalaya and Research Centre:

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


Constitution Day



Power-Point Presentation Competition:

On the **4th of February 2023**, the Department of Physics at R.K.T College organized a Power-Point Presentation Competition, engaging students in an academic and creative endeavor to enhance their presentation skills. Under the leadership of I/c. Principal Dr. Geetha Menon, the event was meticulously planned by Convenor Ms. Sangeeta Mankani and Coordinator Sanjay V. Lalla, with valuable contributions from Dr. Richa Badlani and Ms. Bhagyashree Pathai. The competition was aimed at college-level participants, focusing on enriching students' understanding of PowerPoint as a tool for academic presentations, boosting their confidence, and helping them overcome stage fear.

The competition saw the registration of 25 students from both TYBSc and FYBSc, out of which 10 were shortlisted to present in the final round. Physics Projects Exhibition:

On the **28th of February 2023**, the Department of Physics at R.K.T. College celebrated National Science Day by organizing an innovative Physics Projects Exhibition, specifically designed for FYBSc students. This activity, held in the Physics Laboratory over three hours, was part of the college-level engagement aimed at showcasing physics experiments and encouraging students to explore and demonstrate their scientific acumen. Their projects covered a wide range of topics, including Water Conservation, Electricity Generation, Optical illusions, and the functioning of various types of lenses and buzzer alarms. 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


AFTER SOME YEARS


